Welcome to the new school year! A warm welcome to our parents, carers and pupils, especially those of you joining our Hundon School Family for the first time.

We have been working hard at Hundon and Thurlow Primary Federation, both before the term ended and through the summer to enhance further our Federation curriculum. With our return to four classes we have worked hard to review and update our bespoke rolling curriculum, with new themes and supporting class texts to engage and enthuse all our children, ensuring sufficient opportunities to revisit and extend skills as well as introduce new and exciting topics through which our children will gain the subject specific skills and knowledge.

We are also embedding new complementary resources in Maths, Music, Computing and French to further enriching our curriculum 'offer' across all subjects. The children's wellbeing and mental health remains a priority and our excellent pastoral support and learning provision in PSHEE (Personal, Social, Health & Economic Education) and BRAVE (Beliefs, Religions & Values Education) will continue to support these areas.

### FOR YOUR INFORMATION

#### <u>SWIMMING</u>

#### **'MEET THE TEACHER' SESSIONS**

We introduced these some years ago with teachers sharing information on a 'typical' day in the classroom, the timetable, themes, subject details, and so on to support parents in knowing what their child is learning. ### MORNING CLUB AND AFTER-SCHOOL FOOTBALL CLUB

Just a reminder that these sessions cost £2 per session which must be paid for in advance. We still have places available within our morning and football clubs, please speak to the School Office for more information.

#### SCHOOL MEAL REMINDER

The cost of a school meal in Years 3 to 6 is  $\pm 2.50$  (a week is  $\pm 12.50$ .) **School meals MUST be paid for in advance**. Payment is required online where a minimum of five meals must be purchased at any one time. The cost of the first half of the Autumn term is  $\pm 82.50$ .
