#### SCHOOL MEAL PRICE INCREASE

After the Easter holidays the price of a school meal for children in Year 3 through to Year 6 will increase from £2.50 per day to £2.60. This increase is due to rising costs linked to food prices and our catering service. This change will take place from Tuesday 16th April when term starts.
