We have dusted off the school Christmas Post Box! It is now located opposite the school office in the reception area ready for the children to post their cards.

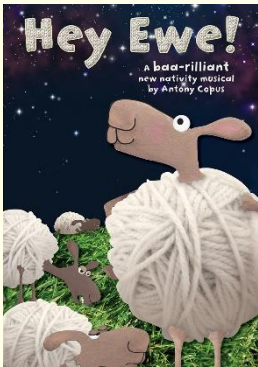
The last day for posting will be Monday 12th of December.

Performances will be at 9.30am and 2pm.

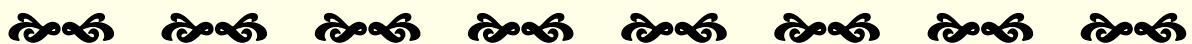
SEVERE WEATHER

Parents and Carers of 3 and 4 year old children, have you applied for a full-time school place for your child?

If you have a child born between **1st September 2018** and **31st August 2019** you must apply for a place by midnight on Sunday **15th January 2023**.

Applications should be made online at www.suffolk.gov.uk/onlineadmissions

Choosing the right primary school for your child is one of the most important decisions you will have to make.
