## UNITY SCHOOLS PARTNERSHIP TWO-WEEK HALF TERM 'PILOT' IN OCTOBER 2023

Our Chair of Governors recently wrote to yourselves detailing Hundon Community Primary School's position and views regarding Unity's 'pilot'.

To be clear, we are a Suffolk County Council maintained school, retaining our autonomy as a self-governing primary school. We are not part of the Unity Schools Partnership.

Suffolk County Council sets our term dates centrally, <u>more than two years in advance</u>. We cannot alter our term dates and Hundon's half-term will <u>not</u> be the same as Unity's. It will be Monday 23rd October to Friday 27th October as previously published.

We **do not agree with the rationale put forward** and have shared our views and concerns with **Tim Coulson**, **Unity's Chief Executive**, highlighting the **negative impact on pupils**, **families and staff**. <u>We do not believe the benefits of the 'pilot' outweigh the children's</u> <u>loss of learning</u>. We have also raised the matter with our local MP, Matt Hancock.

We know Unity's 'pilot' is going to **adversely affect many of you financially, practically and logistically**.

## MORNING SPORTS CLUB / AFTER-SCHOOL CLUB ON A WEDNESDAY ~ CHANGES

The **numbers** using the additional childcare we facilitate through provision of **daily morning sports club** and our **after-school club on a Wednesday** have **increased significantly** since their introduction. To **accommodate** this **rise in numbers** we will be **increasing** the **staffing levels** within these clubs. This is to **ensure all aspects of child protection and safeguarding** are met and the **health and safety** of those in attendance is assured.

Whilst we will continue to **subsidise the costs incurred by this provision**, primarily using our PE and Sports Funding, we **cannot financially support** the **increase to staff costs**.

**From September, attendance at morning sports club and after-school club** will incur **a 'flat-rate' charge of £2.00 per session, per child**. Places will continue to be limited, allocated on a first come, first served basis and priority given to working parents and those in receipt of pupil premium funding.

Prestige Sports will continue to deliver this additional childcare provision, ensuring school staff can concentrate on the core business of teaching and learning.

As before, we direct working families with extended childcare requirements to our associate 'HAPPY DAYS CHILDCARE'. They are located a mere 8 minutes from us, just off the A143 and have provision available from 7am until 6.30pm, Monday to Friday, including transport to and from school and light meals as needed.
