<u>School Meals ~ An Update</u>

You will remember earlier this year I wrote to you about the increases to our catering service costs as well as highlighting the increase in food prices. When the additional costs began in April the governing body made the decision to cover the shortfall between the income from school meals and all costs associated with providing meals for our pupils within the Federation in the short-term given the limited notice provided as well as the economic climate.

Unfortunately, this is not something we can sustain for the long term without impacting teaching and learning provision, therefore, reluctantly, we will be increasing the prices of school meals from £2.30 (static since 2014) to £2.50 from the start of the new academic year in September 2023.

This does not affect those of you whose child/ren have school meals through the government's 'universal free school meal' offer for children in Reception through to Year 2 or entitlement due to eligibility for Pupil Premium Funding.

MORNING SPORTS CLUB / AFTER SCHOOL CLUB ON A WEDNESDAY ~ REMINDER

Earlier this term we shared with you the popularity of the additional childcare we facilitate through the provision of daily morning sports club and our after-school club on a Wednesday. We highlighted the need to increase the staffing levels within these clubs to ensure all aspects of child protection and safeguarding are met and the health and safety of those in attendance is assured.

As was shared at the time whilst we will continue to subsidise the costs incurred, primarily using our PE and Sports Funding, we cannot financially support the increase to staff costs.

This is a reminder that from the start of the new academic year in September 2023 attendance at morning sports club and after-school club will incur a 'flat-rate' charge of £2.00 per session, per child.

Places will continue to be limited, allocated on a first come, first served basis and priority given to working parents and those in receipt of pupil premium funding. from the start of the new academic year in September 2023.

To use this facility please book your place with the School Office and be sure to make your payments in advance using the usual online facility.

As before, we direct working families with extended childcare requirements to our associate 'HAPPY DAYS CHILDCARE'. They are located a mere 8 minutes from us, just off the A143 and have provision available from 7am until 6.30pm, Monday to Friday, including transport to and from school and light meals as needed.
